

Union Assurance Cookie Policy

Please read this cookie policy carefully as it applies to our use of cookies in connection with Union Assurance web site.

We use cookies to help make your visits to our websites a better experience, and this policy explains how we do just that. Please be aware that your browser settings may automatically accept our cookies. For information about how to adjust your browser settings please see below (3. Accept or Block Cookies).

Remember, you are in control, and can adjust these settings at any time.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files which contain information that is downloaded to your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. When you visit the website again or visit another website which recognises a cookie you've previously downloaded, your device communicates with the website and the website can read the information held in that cookie.

First party cookies come from the site you are currently using, for example, unionassurance.com. You can also enable "third party cookies", which are cookies placed by our approved business partners from a different website. For example should we use Google advertising services on unionassurance.com, their website cookies may be placed on the site you are visiting.

There are also different types of cookies, which do slightly different things;

Session cookies stay in place only for the duration of your visit to our website and are deleted at the end of your browsing session.

"Persistent cookies" remain on your device until the expiry date and time set by the website.

2. How we use cookies?

We use cookies to improve your experience when you browse our websites (for example to show you information that is relevant to you, based on the sort of web content you've looked at before) and to save you time by not having to re-enter your details each time you visit. We also use cookies to see how people interact with our websites, so we can make improvements to the site that make it easier to use.

3. Accept or Block Cookies

You can block any cookies from any website by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of some or all cookies. You can also use your browser settings to delete cookies.

If you share the use of a computer, accepting or rejecting the use of cookies may affect all users of that computer.

This cookie policy is subject to amendments and changes at any time at Union Assurance sole discretion. Accordingly, we suggest that you check this cookie policy periodically for updates.
